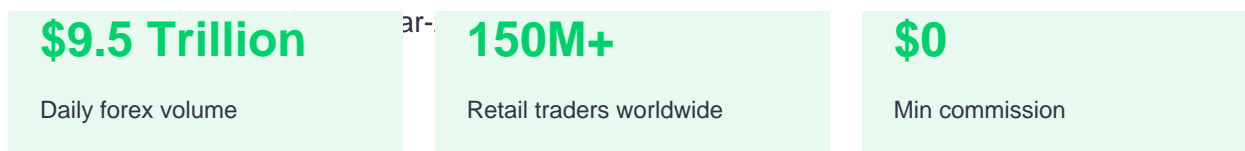

The Opportunity

Commission-free trading has removed the biggest barrier to entry. Platforms like eToro and Interactive Brokers now offer \$0 commissions on stocks and ETFs, meaning more of your money goes toward building wealth, not paying broker fees.

Copy trading lets beginners mirror the strategies of verified profitable traders. Fractional shares let you own pieces of expensive stocks like Amazon or Google starting from just \$1.

The Risk Reality

Important: Approximately 70-80% of retail CFD/forex accounts lose money. Trading is not a get-rich-quick scheme. This guide teaches you how to manage risk, start small, and build skills before scaling up. The difference between profitable traders and the rest? Risk management, patience, and education.

Getting Started: Account Setup

3 simple steps to open your first trading account

1 Sign Up & Verify Your Identity

- " Visit the platform website and click "Sign Up" or "Create Account"
- " Provide your email address and create a strong password
- " Complete KYC verification: upload government ID + proof of address
- " Verification takes 1-3 business days (eToro and IBKR often same-day)

2 Fund Your Account

- " Link your bank account or debit card for deposits
- " Start small: \$100-\$500 is perfect for beginners
- " Most platforms support bank transfer, debit/credit card, and e-wallets
- " Only deposit money you can afford to lose - never trade with rent money

3 Place Your First Trade

- " Use the search bar to find a stock, ETF, or crypto you want to trade
- " Review the asset details, charts, and analyst sentiment
- " Set your position size (start small!), set a stop-loss, click "Buy"
- " Monitor your positions from the portfolio dashboard

Pro Tips

- " Use Plus500's free demo account to practice before risking real money
- " On eToro, start with CopyTrader to learn by watching pros trade
- " IBKR Lite users: Enable fractional shares to invest any dollar amount
- " Always enable two-factor authentication (2FA) on your trading account

5 Beginner-Proof Strategies

1 Dollar-Cost Averaging (DCA)

Risk: Low | Timeframe: Long-term

Invest a fixed amount on a regular schedule (e.g., \$50 every Monday) regardless of price. This smooths out volatility and removes emotion from trading.

Best on IBKR Lite with fractional shares - automate weekly buys of index ETFs (SPY, VTI).

2 Copy Trading

Risk: Medium | Timeframe: Medium-term

Mirror the trades of verified profitable investors automatically. Choose who to copy based on their track record, risk score, and strategy.

Best on eToro CopyTrader - browse top investors, allocate budget, platform mirrors their moves.

3 Index Fund Investing

Risk: Low | Timeframe: 5+ years

Buy broad market index funds (S&P 500, Total Market) for instant diversification with near-zero effort. Historical average return: ~10%/year.

Best on IBKR - access every major ETF at zero commission with IBKR Lite.

4 Swing Trading

Risk: Medium-High | Timeframe: Days to weeks

Identify stocks or crypto in strong trends and ride the momentum. Use moving averages and RSI to time entries and exits.

Best on Plus500 or eToro - use charting tools to spot setups on trending assets.

5 Dividend Growth Investing

Risk: Low-Medium | Timeframe: Years

Buy stocks with growing dividends. Reinvest dividends to compound returns. Focus on companies with 10+ years of consecutive increases.

Best on IBKR - widest selection of dividend stocks, fractional shares, lowest fees.

Risk Management Essentials

The framework that separates winners from losers

The 2% Rule

Never risk more than 2% of your total portfolio on a single trade. This is the most important rule in trading. It ensures that no single losing trade can significantly damage your account.

Example: You have \$1,000 in your account.

2% = \$20 maximum risk per trade.

Buy a stock at \$50, stop-loss at \$48 (risking \$2/share) = max 10 shares.

Always Use Stop-Loss Orders

A stop-loss automatically sells your position if the price drops to a predetermined level. It is your insurance policy against catastrophic losses.

- " Set your stop-loss BEFORE you enter a trade, never after
- " Place it at a logical level (below support, below recent low)
- " Never move your stop-loss further away from your entry
- " Use trailing stops to lock in profits as a trade moves your way

Position Sizing Formula

$$\text{Position Size} = (\text{Account Size} \times 2\%) / (\text{Entry Price} - \text{Stop-Loss Price})$$

Diversification Checklist

Never put more than 20% of your portfolio in a single stock

Spread across sectors: tech, healthcare, finance, energy

Include different asset classes: stocks, bonds, crypto, commodities

Geographic diversification: don't invest only in one country

Rebalance quarterly to maintain your target allocation

Week-by-week blueprint to start trading smart

WEEK 1: Foundation

- j Open account on your chosen platform (eToro, Plus500, or IBKR)
- j Complete identity verification (KYC)
- j Fund your account with \$100-\$500
- j Explore the platform interface - don't trade yet!
- j Use Plus500's demo to practice with virtual funds

WEEK 2: Education

- j Learn to read basic candlestick charts
- j Understand support and resistance levels
- j Study 3 assets you're interested in
- j Set up your watchlist with 10-15 assets
- j Practice 5 demo trades using stop-losses

WEEK 3: First Trades

- j Execute your first real trade - keep it SMALL
- j Buy a broad index ETF (SPY or VTI) - safest start
- j Set a stop-loss on every position (no exceptions)
- j Start a trading journal: record every trade + reasoning
- j If using eToro, allocate \$100 to CopyTrader

WEEK 4: Refine & Scale

- j Review your journal - what worked, what didn't?
- j Calculate your win rate and average P/L ratio
- j Adjust strategy based on results
- j Set up automated DCA: weekly buy of top picks
- j Plan next month's investment budget
